Re: Quarterly Steering Committee Meeting Information Dissemination

- Sherry Chow, Ph.D. University of Arizona, University of Arizona Cancer Prevention Clinical Trials Network (UA CP-CTNet) was named the new chair of the CP-CTNet Steering Committee today and will serve a one-year term.
- Powel H. Brown, M.D. University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center, iCAN-PREVENT: International Cancer Prevention Clinical Trial Consortium was named the new co-chair of the 2021 Investigators' Site Coordinators' Opportunity for Research Excellence (I-SCORE) Meeting which likely will be held virtually due to the ongoing pandemic and the chair-elect for the Steering Committee. The DCP co-chair for the meeting will be named in the near future.
- A request from UA CP-CTNet for Rapid Response Restricted Fund was voted on and approved for the following proposal: "Biomarker Discovery and Validation for Early Phase Clinical Trials for Melanoma Prevention" which was presented by Sherry Chow, Karen Hastings, Clara Curiel, and Bonnie LaFleur (UAZ).
- A concept for the first CP-CTNet cross-network trial "A randomized Phase IIa study
 of Multitargeted Recombinant Adenovirus 5 (CEA/MUC1/Brachyury) Vaccine (TriAd5) in Lynch syndrome" is being developed by Drs. Ajay Bansal and Eduardo VilarSanchez for submission to DCP in January 2021. This will involve all five LAOs.
- DMACC Update: Prepared for the first CP-CTNet study to open
